Think Big...Think Imperial Crane

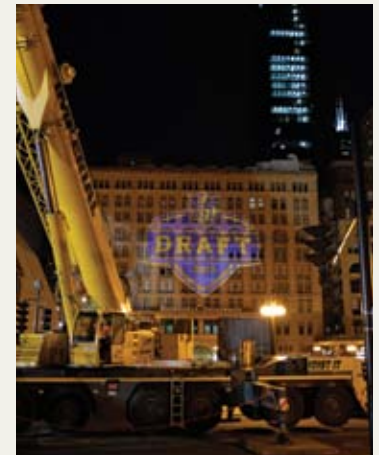
With the help of Imperial Crane, Chicago Bears fans will experience replays, video features, in-game stats and scores on two new video scoreboards at Soldier Field. Imperial Crane replaced the existing scoreboards that were in place since 2003 in the south and north end zone. The newest scoreboards measure 128 feet wide and 40 feet high. The new scoreboards will have the highest video quality in the NFL and will be 310% larger than the previous scoreboards.

One of the challenges to this job was to protect the football field while driving two cranes weighing over 200,000 pounds. Imperial placed matting down on the field to protect the irrigation system six inches below the grass. Imperial also hoisted the glass curtain walls from the exterior of the Field to complete the scoreboard project. With the scoreboards in place, this will be new and exciting season for Bears fans.

Imperial Crane Services is continuing their trend of growth and expansion through a recent purchase of \$10.5 million dollars in crane equipment. The full list of cranes include:

Imperial felt that this was the right time to make a substantial commitment to purchase this equipment. Thinking Outside The Box

This job originally called for multiple set-ups within the plant's innermost security fencing. After acquiescing to the logistic log jam ahead, a previously half-hearted mention of 'let's put the crane on the beach' was revisited.

An aggressive re-imagining took place and the result was a 700' access road, complete with four bridges, over 1600' sq. ft. of outrigger matting, a custom 40' x 60' berm, and a single set-up for the duration of the job.

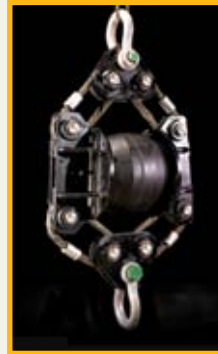

Pile Driving Solutions Inc. became the official distributor of the TÜNKERS® Vibratory Damper in January 2015. This product now allows the use of hydraulic cranes to be used for vibratory hammer work with little to no impact on the crane. It provides extended protection to all cranes from the vibration put out by the hammers.



The damper can be used on all model cranes. Manufacturers like Liebherr require that dampers or isolators be used when vibratory hammers are placed on LR model cranes.

Imperial Crane Services was presented with a safety award at the Northwest Indiana Business Roundtable (NWIBRT) Awards Banquet – Honoring Excellence in Construction in May of 2015. The Achievement Award recognized companies with Days Away From Work (DAFW) and Total Recordable Incident Rate (TRIR) lower than the NWI industry average, an EMR < .9 and the ability to demonstrate an acceptable safety management system.

At the SC&RA (Specialized Carriers & Rigging Association) in April, Imperial Crane won the Crane & Rigging Group Safety award and the Crane Operator Safety award.

Imperial Crane was presented with a safety award at the Association of Subcontractors & Affiliates (ASA Chicago) 20th Annual Safety Award Program in front of its General Contractor Council. Member companies were awarded for their success in lowering a combination of safety-related factors, including their Experience Modification Rate (EMR), OSHA Recordables and Citations, and the DART Score.
